

Master Asher's Guide to Your First Club Envidious Munch

Now that you've decided to attend one of our Thursday night munch dinners, you're probably asking yourself – *Now what*? Use this handy guide to make your first munch experience with us a fun, relaxing, non-intimidating introduction to our kinky community.

Logistics

- ❖ We normally hold our Thursday night munch dinners at 7:00pm at Golden Horns Steak and Char House (a member of the Envy Entertainment family of companies), but we sometimes like to mix things up so we recommend you inquire at Club Envidious and also let them know you'll be attending.
- ❖ When you arrive at the restaurant, ask to be seated with the Asher party.
- ❖ Our dress code is simple. For obvious reasons do not attend wearing fetish wear. We're not trying to draw attention to ourselves. Just wear what you'd normally wear when you go out to dinner with friends.

Social Protocol/Interaction

- ❖ It's ok if you're nervous, there will always be a munch coordinator in attendance. They will introduce themselves and do their best to make you feel welcome. It doesn't matter how kinky you are or what level of BDSM you engage in, you're in the right place.
- There's no reason to be worried about who you might meet. Attendees will look like average people, much like the "vanilla" restaurant guests. You might see a submissive wearing a collar as some attendees are completely "out" while others are not.
- ❖ Don't worry if you're shy, the munch coordinator will encourage attendees to chat, mix and mingle. We talk about everything − work, kids, current events, sports, movies, vacation plans, pet antics as well as kink and BDSM.
- ❖ I and/or big sister Mistress Lauren like to attend when time and schedules allow.
- ❖ Touching while it's appropriate to offer your hand for a handshake, hugs (and kisses) are normally reserved for those who know each other well.
- ❖ Boundaries Some couples in attendance might not welcome contact in their personal space, especially Dominant/submissive couples. It is common courtesy to ask a Dominant if you can speak to their submissive. If the submissive initiates conversation with you, you may feel free to do so. Don't hesitate to ask if you're not sure.
- Munches are not for hook ups Our munches are not meant to be pick up joints. Unless the munch coordinator says it's all right, don't put yourself out there as being available and looking. The purpose of our munch is to relax and socialize – not hook up.

4 Privacy

- ❖ Your name It's not uncommon to use a different name than your real name for BDSM events like a munch or at a BDSM club. This allows you to custom pick a name that reflects your unique personality and provides anonymity if you want it. The name you choose to give is left to your discretion.
- ❖ Where you're from You're not required to tell anyone where you live. You can just give the city or the next city over that you're from. We all take our privacy very seriously, especially when it comes to names and locations. No one will be offended if you prefer not to share where you're from.
- ❖ If someone recognizes you There's no need to panic if you recognize someone at our munch. They probably don't want to be recognized either. If they don't approach you, you can just nod in recognition and leave it at that. If they do approach you, you can respond casually with something like "It's great that someone I know is kinky too."

Keep this in mind, if they "out" you, they're also "outing" themselves. They would have to explain why they were attending the same munch you were. If you're concerned they're going to tell everyone you both know, just ask them not to say anything. Our community values its privacy.

Parting Thoughts

- ❖ I sincerely hope this guide has lessened your fears and reduced your anxiety about attending your first munch with us.
- ❖ Attending our munch is a critical first step if you want to move beyond just reading about kink and BDSM.
- ❖ It's all right to be scared or apprehensive, but take that leap of faith and join us anyway. You won't regret it.
- Ask plenty of questions, that's the only way you'll know if BDSM and the Club Envidious community are the right fit for you. You're attending to learn so don't be shy.
- Lastly and most importantly relax and enjoy yourself. The food at Golden Horns is delicious and the desserts are to die for. Let the evening flow naturally. Have fun, share some laughs and engage in lively conversation. It will soothe your soul.
